Cash rebates are available now to all new commercial and multifamily buildings (4 or more units). To be eligible, projects must complete an application form and receive a subsequent authorization letter **before** any fixtures are installed.

### MULTIFAMILY AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

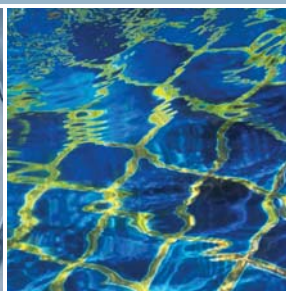
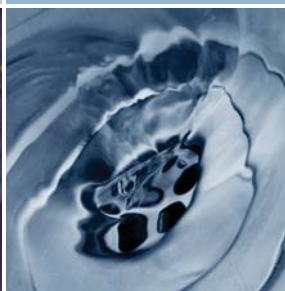
- High-efficiency Toilets** ..... **\$50 rebate**  
*1.28 gpf or less, WaterSense labeled (see [www.epa.gov/watersense](http://www.epa.gov/watersense))*
- Showerheads** ..... **free or \$5 rebate**  
*Free from the utility or get a rebate for 1.5 to 2.0 gpm products*
- Bathroom Faucet Aerator Nozzles** ..... **free or \$2 rebate**  
*Free from the utility or get a rebate for 1.0 gpm products in multifamily buildings or 0.5 gpm products in commercial buildings*
- Irrigation Systems** ..... **\$300–450 rebate**  
*Soil moisture sensors with conservation controller or weather-based controller with rain sensor (see [www.savingwater.org](http://www.savingwater.org))*

### COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS ONLY

- High-efficiency Urinals** ..... **\$100 rebate**  
*0.5 gpf or less (water-free urinals under study — no rebate)*
- Time-of-Use Data: main water meter** ..... **\$250 rebate**  
*Hooked up to energy management system*
- Commercial Coin-op Washers** ..... **\$300 rebate**  
*Tier 2 and above (see [www.cee1.org](http://www.cee1.org))*
- Qualified Kitchen Equipment** ..... **varies**

- Other Qualified Technologies** ..... **\$10 per gallon per day saved**
