## **Frequently Asked Questions WaterSense Toilet Rebate Program**

### **1. Who qualifies for a rebate?**

Qualifying customers are single-family residents or duplex customers who are served by a Saving Water Partnership (SWP) utility. Duplex customers must have separate utility bills. ### **2. How much is the rebate?**

The rebate is \$30 per toilet.

### **3. Is there a limit to the number of rebates?**

Yes, SWP will offer one rebate per household. For duplexes, the building must have separate utility bills in order to receive more than one. Rebates are available until funds run out.

### **4. Which toilets qualify for the rebate?**

Any toilet that has a WaterSense label will qualify for a rebate.

### **5. Why should I buy a WaterSense toilet?**

WaterSense toilets use even less water than the Federal Plumbing Code standard, yet they perform just as well, if not better than other toilets on the market. Toilets bearing the WaterSense label have been independently laboratory-tested. They must reliably flush a minimum of 350 grams (three-quarters of a pound) of solid waste and use no more than 1.28 gallons per flush. Some models will flush up to 1,000 grams (2.2 pounds) of solid waste, while maintaining maximum water efficiency.

### **6. Where can I purchase a WaterSense-labeled toilet?**

**7. How do I get an application?**
