Rebate Application Procedure

1. Confirm building is located in the Saving Water Partnership service territory (see list, below left.) Determine # of toilets to be replaced (**only pre-1994 eligible for replacement**) for accurate number. This program does not replace 1.6 gpf toilets.
2. Complete application to receive up to \$100 rebate per toilet (or less if cost of toilet is under \$100) for a WaterSense labeled toilet.
3. Send or fax the application: **SPU - Multifamily Toilet Program**

4. Receive your authorization letter from us. An authorization packet will arrive within two weeks of receiving your application. Toilets must be purchased after you receive authorization, and choose a toilet from the **WaterSense** list. www.epa.gov/watersense/pp/het.htm. **Only WaterSense toilets are eligible for a rebate.**
5. Install new toilets. **You must replace all old toilets (pre-1994) and the building must be 4+ units.**
6. **Complete your project and submit project completion information within 30 days of authorization letter date.**

If receiving toilets through the free toilet program, the Applicant expressly agrees to waive any claims against Seattle Public Utilities as a distributor of such toilets. Applicant may be billed for any delivered toilets that are not installed or not returned to the vendor within 30 days of delivery.
- Seattle Public Utilities shall have the right, but not the obligation, to inspect the installed toilets for the sole purpose of verifying that installations are in conformance with the rebate program requirements. Inspections are not a certification, warranty or other approval with respect to the Applicant's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, and building codes.
- Seattle Public Utilities has not and does not make any representations or promises with respect to toilets, showerheads, and faucet aerators, their water consumption, and/or water savings from the installed products.
