ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Building must be located in one of these participating Saving Water Partnership utilities:

 - Woodinville Water District
- Only Premium 1.1 (or less) gpf toilets are eligible. Use this [list of toilets](#) to find a qualifying toilet or go to www.savingwater.org/rebates
- Maximum of two (2) rebated toilets per unit
- Must replace existing toilets that are pre-2004 and have not been rebated before. An inspection may be required to verify the age of existing toilets.
- Building must have at least four units
- For condos, an individual can participate in the [single family toilet rebate program](#), or the association can apply using this application

TAKE THESE 5 EASY STEPS:

1. Check to see if you are eligible for this program - see green box at left.
2. Get Authorized: Submit this completed application along with a W-9 and list of the property's units to melissa.levo@seattle.gov or mail to: SPU - Multifamily Toilet Rebates

3. After receiving authorization (a site inspection or picture documentation may be required to verify the age of existing toilets), buy and install [eligible toilets](#) as needed. Authorizations are valid for up to 3 years.
4. Submit a request for a rebate and detailed receipts within 90 days of purchasing the new toilets. A site inspection may be required.
5. Receive a check for up to \$100 per toilet. Eligible costs include toilet bowl, tank, and tax. Gift cards and store credit are not eligible forms of payment.
